**Children served at Sunshine Children’s Home-** Sunshine Children’s Home served a total of 97 children during the months of August and September, with residents ranging from 2 days to 17 years old. We have served 58 counties and kept over 230 sibling sets together. Since opening, SCH has officially served 1,336 children.
